English Language Competency for Nursing and Midwifery courses at Curtin University



In addition to satisfying Curtin University's minimum English standard requirement for Nursing and Midwifery courses, all applicants must also demonstrate English language proficiency as specified in the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia's (NMBA) English language skills registration standard.

- 2. You have achieved the required minimum scores of IELTS 7.0/7.0 (or equivalent test score for one of the NMBA accepted tests* as stated here: English competency equivalents charts) and the test was undertaken within two years of the course commencement date.
- * NMBA Accepted Tests: Cambridge (C1 or C2), IELTS, OET, PTE Academic, TOEFL iBT.
